This is the 2022 edition of a series of enrichment booklets for long-term care residents. This book serves to keep residents entertained and active. This edition includes activities to encourage residents to communicate with each other, with staff, and with visitors in order to broaden their community within and outside of their home.

Included in the activities are puzzles, prompts for conversation or writing, trivia to challenge yourself or others, an icebreaker activity, and art pages for relaxing.

Know Your Rights

Residents of nursing homes have rights that are guaranteed by the federal Nursing Home Reform Law. The law requires nursing homes to "promote and protect the rights of each resident" and stresses individual dignity and self-determination.




Icebreaker Scavenger Hunt
